

Privacy Notice

I. Identity and Address of the Data Controller

Félix, Martínez y Bacelis, S.C. (“FMB Abogados” or the “Controller”), in compliance with the *Federal Law on Protection of Personal Data Held by Private Parties* (LFPDPPP), its Regulations, and the Privacy Notice Guidelines, hereby makes available this privacy notice (the “Notice”).

II. Personal Data Collected

To fulfill the purposes described in this Notice, FMB Abogados may collect: full name, address, date and place of birth, nationality, email address, phone number, employer or company, tax ID (RFC), population registry code (CURP), fiscal and banking information (the latter, subject to express consent), information about legal representatives, and KYC questionnaire data.

Sensitive personal data: image (e.g., government-issued ID) and biometric data, when required for security purposes or by law.

Third-party data: if you provide information about a third party, you must notify that person of this Notice and the scope of the processing.

III. Purposes of Processing

a. Purposes that do not require your consent:

(i) Contacting you and providing the requested legal services; (ii) internal administration, billing, and collections; (iii) compliance with legal and regulatory obligations; (iv) responding to requests from competent authorities; (v) identity verification and due diligence activities (KYC/AML/compliance).

b. Secondary purposes (require your consent):

Sending newsletters, legal updates, event invitations, and commercial prospecting communications. If you do not wish your data to be used for these purposes, please notify us at pfc@fmbabogados.com.mx.

IV. Transfer of Personal Data

FMB Abogados may transfer your personal data, within and outside Mexico, in the following cases: (i) to authorities or regulators, in compliance with legal obligations; (ii) to notaries, public brokers, appraisers, translators, auditors, or other advisors involved in the legal matter;

(iii) to technology and infrastructure service providers; (iv) in the exceptional cases permitted by the LFPDPPP. Such transfers are necessary to fulfill our legal and contractual obligations and, except as provided by law, do not require your consent.

V. Security Measures

The Controller implements the technical, administrative, and physical measures necessary to protect your personal data against damage, loss, alteration, destruction, or unauthorized use, access, or processing. All information containing personal data is treated as confidential.

VI. ARCO Rights, Revocation, and Limitation

You may exercise your rights of Access, Rectification, Cancellation, or Opposition (“ARCO Rights”), revoke your consent, or request limitation of the use of your data by sending a request to pfc@fmbabogados.com.mx. Your request must include: (i) full name and address; (ii) valid government-issued ID or notarized power of attorney for a representative; (iii) a clear description of the ARCO right you wish to exercise and the data involved.

The Controller will respond within 20 business days. If the request is granted, the requested measures will take effect within the following 15 business days. If you are dissatisfied with the response, you may file a complaint with the competent data protection authority.

VII. Changes to this Privacy Notice

Any amendments to this Notice will be published at www.fmbabogados.com.mx and will take effect seven business days after publication.

VIII. Consent

By providing your personal data, using our services, or browsing our website without objecting, you are deemed to grant your tacit consent to the processing of your data in accordance with this Notice. For secondary purposes or sensitive data, express consent will be required.
